Larry W. Beward, Wendorf Beward & Partners, LLC (WB&P), has more than 45 years of experience in leadership, management, education, strategic planning, security/safety, operations management, logistics, and customer support. Larry successfully built and led teams that produced strong results for the United States Air Force (USAF) and The City of San Antonio (CoSA). Larry supported and collaborated generals, executive appointees and elected officials throughout his federal and local government careers.

In a 29-year career with the USAF Larry's leadership and training expertise was used at the American Embassies in Cairo, Egypt and Manama Bahrian to develop a logistics support system and the F-16 pilot training syllabus as part of the United States Security Assistance Program. Larry supported the Secretary of Defense and senior USAF leadership on closing England Air Force Base, La. During the Gulf War, he strategized alternatives and prepared the Commander of Air Combat Command for Congressional briefings on air force capabilities and support strategies.

Larry began his career in logistics management and became a certified master trainer for the United States Air Force where he conducted training for 14,000 personnel in the areas of leadership, management, communications, logistics, and asset management. He conducted non-commissioned officer leadership training and graduated over 5,000 students. Additionally, he held numerous command positions to include Commander, 39th Supply Squadron, Incirlik Air Base Turkey. This 427person unit was selected as the best Supply Squadron in the USAF while under his command.

CoSA hired Larry after 9/11/01 to set up a security system for all CoSA property (450+ buildings and facilities). His demonstrated leadership skills led to expansion of his role to include facility management. He supervised over 165 people and was used to conduct training classes on communication skills, security procedures, and workplace violence response to over 2,000 people.

Larry left the CoSA and returned to the USAF community, managing the Fuels Operations at Joint Base San Antonio. During this time, he was selected to conduct training to 5,000 personnel on Sexual Assault Prevention, Suicide Prevention and Active Shooter Response.

Larry has a Master's Degree in Human Resources Management and a Bachelor's Degree in Sociology. He received the Lance P. Sijian Leadership Award by the Commander, United States Air Forces Europe and was selected as the Senior Civilian of the Year at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas.
